### **JUST FOR ALL PROJECT**

Just4All is a project co-funded by the European Union Justice Program (2014-2020) whose objective is to improve real access to justice for persons with disabilities and thus contribute to the effective application of the Charter of Fundamental Rights of the European Union, the United Nations Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities and the European Union regulations on disability.

To achieve these objectives this project -led by ONCE Foundation, and with the collaboration of the partners European Disability Forum, European Association of Service Providers for Persons with Disabilities, Thomson Reuters and the Human Rights Institute Gregorio Peces-Barba, former Bartolomé de las Casas, of Carlos III University of Madrid- have designed a MASSIVE OPEN ONLINE COURSE on the rights of persons with disabilities primarily designed for use by legal practitioners, specially lawyers and notaries, but also to a broader public.
